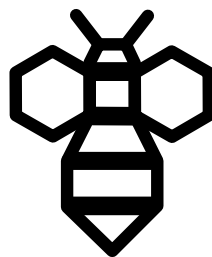

Living Books



Living books are vital to a Charlotte Mason education. Books chosen with the utmost care and precision, and written in such a way so as to capture the imaginations of the children.

These books, written in an engaging, narrative style, speak to the soul of the child, providing food and nourishment for the mind.



Living Ideas

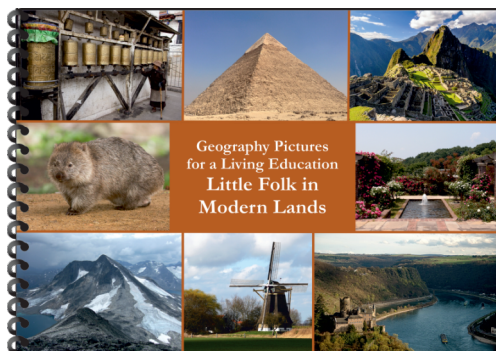

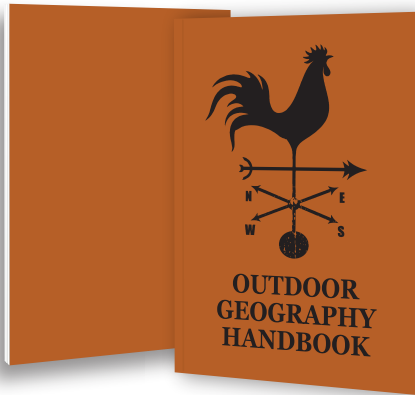
About the Author

About the Author

Edmund Selous was a naturalist, ornithologist and writer of natural history books for adults and children. Born in London in 1857 he was a reclusive man and kept much to himself but his love of the natural world, particularly birds, led him to publish several books on his special subject of interest. His informal, conversational style of writing was popular with children. His *Tommy Smith* series was highly regarded by **Charlotte Mason**, who assigned them for her Form I students on a consistent basis.

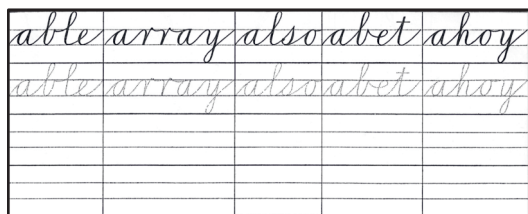

Vere Foster's Copy-Books were first published in 1865 and were used widely in schools across the world for more than a century. The goal was simple: to train pupils in writing words continuously, that is, from end to end, without lifting the pen, and to simplify the writing style for the ordinary person.

Mr. Foster believed that better penmanship and literacy skills would mean better chances of employment for the working classes. Convinced that teachers did not have the adequate resources to instruct their pupils in literacy he made it a lifelong mission to improve the situation.



The Victorian philanthropist's style of writing is synonymous with the handwriting of yesteryear and was likely taught to your parents and grandparents in their school days.

Our physical editions are as true to the originals as possible, printed in A5 booklets on tough 170gsm paper. Our digital editions have been reformatted in A4 size so as to be more compatible with home printers. Bundles are available across the range.

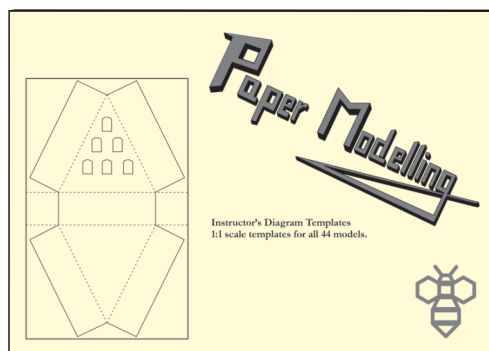


About the Author

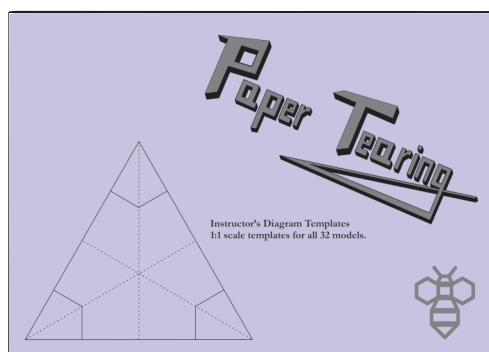

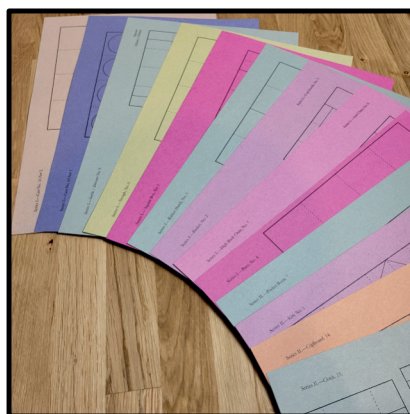

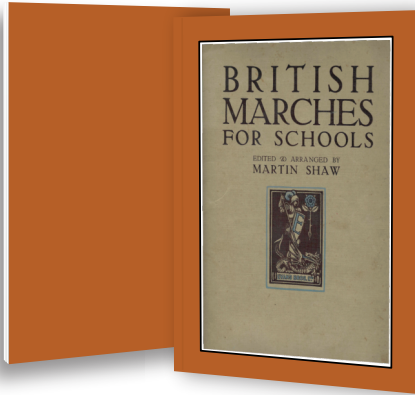
